SHELTER Good, except in strong S/E winds when best shelter is N of Long Island. Schull Hbr access H24. 12 Y ⚓ in NE part of hbr or ⚓ in 3m tca SE of pier, usually lit by street lts all night; keep clear of fairway marked by 8 unlit lateral buoys (summer time only).

NAVIGATION WPT 51°28'.50N 09°40'.50W, 274°/1M to Rock Is It ho. Ent between this It and NCM bn on Black Horse Rks (3/3ca ESE). From S, keep 1ca E of Alderman Rks and 1/2ca off Black Horse Rks bn. Passage between Streak Hd and Alderman Rks is not advised for strangers. Inside the bay the shores are steep to.

LIGHTS AND MARKS Lt ho on Rock Is (conspic W tr) L F WR 85 20m 13/11M; vis outside hbr: W over Long Is Bay-281°-R-340°; vis inside hbr: 281°-R-348°-W-shore(N).

ADJACENT HARBOURS Goleen (Kireal-coeega), Cork, 51°29'.65N 09°42'.21W. AC 2184, 5623. Tides as Crookhaven. A narrow inlet 6ca N of Spanish Pt; good shelter in fair weather, except from SE. 2 churches are easily seen, but ent not visible until close. Keep to S side of ent and anchor fore-and-aft just below quay, where AB also possible. Facilities: P, ☎, Bar.

DUNMANUS BAY, Cork. AC 2552, 5623. Tides see 9.12.26. Appr between Three Castle Hd and Sheep's Hd, Fl (3) WR 15583m 18/15M; no other lts. Ent to Dunmanus Hbr, 51°32'.70N 09°39'.86W, is 1ca wide; breakers both sides. ⚓ in 4m centre of B. Kitchen Cove, 51°35'.50N 09°38'.05W, best of the 3 hbrs; enter W of Owens Is and ⚓ 1ca NNW of it or 2ca further N in 3m. Exposed to S, but good holding. Quay at Ahakista village: AB (drying) FW, ☎, R, Bar. Dunbeacon Hbr, 51°36'.35N 09°33'.60W, is shallow and rock-girt. Quay possible AB in 2m (used by FVs), Slip; anchorage E or SE of Manion Is. Durrus (3/4M): Fuel (cans), R, Bar.

SHELTER Excellent. There are 8 Y ⚓ and 10 daylow R ⚓. Short stay poutoon for up to 4 boats (FW/stores/passengers). ⚓ in middle of bay in 3m; off W tip of Rock Is; and E of Granny Is; last two are far from the village. Holding is patchy, especially in strong SW'lies; beware weed, shellfish beds around shoreline and submarine pipeline from Rock Is to Crookhaven.

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
